All exhibitors should pre-enter their exhibits by completing a paper Entry Form or entering online. Entries will be accepted online from **June 1 to July 15, 2017..** **CHECK-IN FOR ALL EXHIBITS, INCLUDING FLOWERS, HORTICULTURE, AND BAKED ITEMS IS:**

Monday, July 24 from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

1. There will be 3 divisions for the Family Living department : Youth – age 12 and under; Junior – age 13 – 18; and adult – 19 and over. **New Rules – The Creative Arts Tabloid has been revised to reflect new Division numbers. Adults will use the Division 100 series, Juniors, age 13-18 years, will use the Division 200 series, and Youth, age 12 years and under, will use the Division 300 series.**
2. The article must be made by the person exhibiting it.
3. No article previously exhibited at the Fulton County Fair or any other county fair may be entered. **Exhibits may be entered in only one county fair.**
4. Only one item per class may be entered by each individual except for the Wild Card Classes. Wild Card Classes are for items that are not listed in the tabloid and items in these classes should not be duplicated in another class.
5. Soiled and damaged articles will not be accepted.
6. Judging is **Tuesday, July 25th**. The exhibit building will be closed until judging is completed (usually around 2:00 pm.. All exhibits will be judged on the Danish system (unless noted otherwise) and will receive Blue, Red, and White ribbons. Blue ribbons will be worth 3 points, red ribbons 2 points, and white ribbons 1 point unless otherwise indicated. Best of Show awards will be given in each department as indicated for youth, juniors and seniors. Cash awards will be awarded for points earned. No cash awards will be given for the Best of Show awards.
7. The individual earning the most points in the adult and junior or youth departments will be awarded the Shirley Black Award sponsored by the Fulton County Extension Homemakers Council and by the Southfork Antique Gallery. In addition, a special cash award will be given to the club or organization in the junior/youth and adult divisions whose members have the most points. Club membership should be designated on Entry Form or on the online entry. Members may only designate one club.
